

Preparing for Kindergarten

When can I register my child for Kindergarten?

Children who will be 5-years old by Dec. 2, 2010 may enter kindergarten. Registration packets are available on March 8 at the school office. Completed registration packets will be accepted beginning April 7, 2010.

What documents do I need to bring?

You will need to show proof of your child's age. To do that, please bring a birth certificate, baptismal certificate, or passport at the time of registration. You also will have to show proof of your residency within the service boundaries of Ranch View School.

Please bring any of the following:

Current utility bill,

Lease/rental agreement,

Or escrow papers for residency confirmation.

OR

Shared Residency Form. Please pick up from office.

Proof of a physical examination. Our district requires that a Health Examiner give your child a physical examination before entering kindergarten.

Finally, you need to show proof of the following immunizations:

- Polio (4 doses)
- Diphtheria, Tetanus, and Pertussis (5doses)
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) (2 doses)
- Hepatitis B (3doses)
- Varicella (1 dose)
- Tuberculosis skin test (PPD-Mantoux) given and read within one year prior to enrollment.

Your child's immunization record must show the month and year of each dose. (State law does allow children to be exempt from immunization for personal/religious reasons.)

Do I get to choose morning or afternoon kindergarten?

We try to honor requests for morning or afternoon placement on first come first serve basis with priority to residents within our school boundaries.
